Our Apanui School logo beautifully represents the Mātaatua Waka with Whakaari (White Island) in the background, a powerful symbol of our heritage and connection to this region.

The Mātaatua Waka, one of the great voyaging waka, carried our Māori ancestors to the Eastern Bay of Plenty. Guided by the skilled captain Toroa, it landed in Whakatāne more than 700 years ago, marking the beginning of a legacy that continues to inspire us.

Yesterday, I had the privilege of paddling in a waka hourua (double-hulled canoe) with a group of students, and whānau. It was a cool experience that required us to come together as one crew. We paddled in unison, counting to 12 before switching sides, and faced challenges like wind, passing boats, and buoys as we navigated the river.

This experience reminded me of how our school operates as a crew on a waka and how Toroa would have felt leading that waka. At Apanui School, we strive to paddle together in harmony, following systems that guide us forward, much like the counting to 12. Along the way, we encounter obstacles, but together, as a united crew, we overcome them.

From my time here, it's clear that the Apanui School crew—our staff, students, and community—move with a shared sense of purpose and deep love for each other, our kura, and our wider whānau. Like the Mātaatua Waka, we navigate challenges and celebrate achievements together, forging a path forward as one.
